Michele Roberts' work, primitive in feeling and psychological in content, possess a spirit of it's own. Flying snakes, dancing figures, dragons and swords provide the visual vocabulary through which Roberts recounts and explores the complexity and humor of everyday life. In a departure from her earlier works, Roberts' new "Heroes Series" draws upon mythological legends and tales to inspire subconscious investigation. Executed in rich, deep blues, reds, greens, and accented with bold strokes of black; these new works are mysterious yet direct.

A graduate of Art Center College of Design, Roberts has received worldwide attention for her museum and gallery shows. Her most recent shows include; "By Comix Touched" at the Long Beach Museum of Art (reviewed by William Wilson) and "American Pop Culture Today" at the Laforet Museum in Tokyo. Roberts' work is also included in the permanent collection of the Los Angeles County Museum of Art..
